Two Major components of T.A.G.S. are to provide a monthly support and education meeting, and a peer visitor program for new amputees. The peer visitor meets one to one with a new amputee and/or family to discuss their amputation, answer any questions a new amputee might have, give support and encouragement and offer tips to help you to be as independent as possible to return to an active lifestyle. The peer visitor is arranged according to similar ages, amputations and lifestyles with a new amputee.
